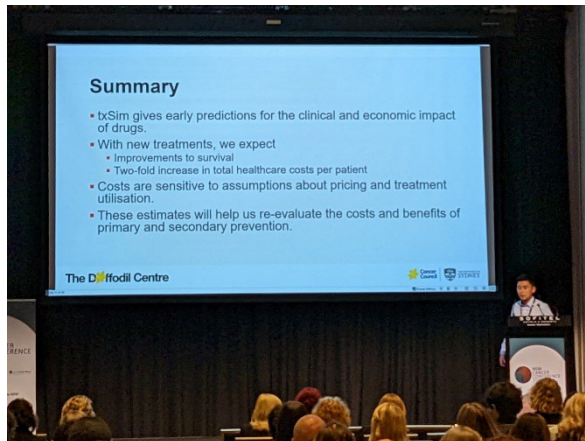

Report

My time at the New South Wales Cancer Conference was very enjoyable and beneficial. Presenting at the conference gave me an opportunity to make my work visible to a broader range of researchers in a number of areas.

I presented a computer simulation that estimated treatment costs and survival time for lung cancer patients – with the goal of producing numbers that could inform budget impact analyses and cost-effectiveness analyses. This work cuts across several disciplines including health economics, epidemiology, medical oncology, and survivorship – only some of which I have expertise in. After my talk, I connected with a number of experts in those areas to receive their thoughtful feedback

on my work. Indeed, in the weeks since the conference, I have connected with one researcher to begin discussions about a possible collaboration to expand on the work that was presented to include other cancer types.

The key highlights of the conference were the fruitful discussions taking place between sessions – in particular with those presenting posters. I was deeply impressed by the diversity of cancer research taking place in New South Wales and Australia overall.
