

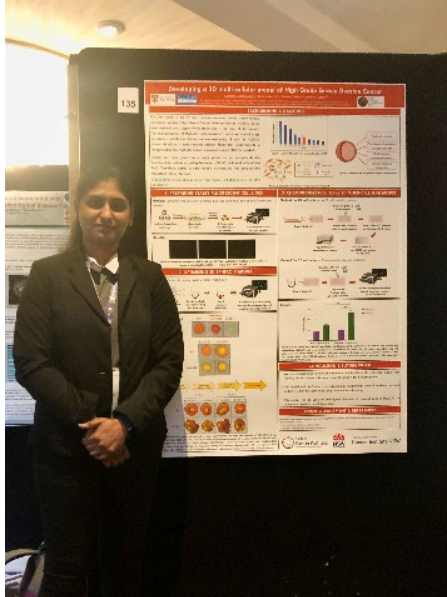
## NSW Cancer Conference 2022 Conference Report
